This is an exhausting trip for this already struggling family, making the need for a location closer to these families critical - but **this will be expensive!**

Our clients come to our Fort Collins office from all over the state (from 47 different zip codes to be exact!), and that is a **significant hardship** for many who come from outside of Fort Collins. 2025 will be a leap for ChildSafe. As we open our second location in Loveland in January, our expenses are increasing.
